Overview of Adolescent Vaccines Requirements

- All 11 year olds (6th Grade) must receive a single dose of Tdap Vaccine.
- All 11 and 12 year olds (6th and 7th grade) must receive a single dose of Meningococcal (Meningitis) vaccine, with a booster dose at age 16 years.
- All girls 11 or 12 years of age should get 3 doses of HPV vaccine to protect against cervical cancer. All boys 11 or 12 years should get 3 does of HPV vaccine to protect against genital warts and Anal cancer.
