ALL KINDERGARTENS

- ❖ 1 Crayon box to keep all supplies in
- ❖ 4 Boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- ❖ 6 Big fat Elmer's glue sticks
- ❖ 1 Coloring book
- ❖ 1 Pack of yellow Ticonderoga pencils
- ❖ 1 Package Crayola washable markers
- ❖ 1 Chalk or marker board eraser

Please do not label these items, because in Kindergarten we share everything.

- ❖ Your child will also need a large backpack (big enough to store a snowsuit and other winter gear) Please do label these with your child's name.

ALL GRADE 1

- ❖ 1 Package of pencils (please buy Ticonderoga, Eagle or Sanford # 2 brand)
- ❖ 1 Pair of Fiskar scissors
- ❖ 2 Dry Erase markers
- ❖ 1 Sock for erasing
- ❖ 1 One-inch binder
- ❖ 1 Medium size plastic supply box
- ❖ 2 Packs of 3 x 3 inch post-it notes
- ❖ 1 Pkg. colored pencils

ALL GRADE 2

- ❖ Please, if possible, buy 4 packages of Ticonderoga, Eagle or Sanford #2 pencils. They sharpen the best and last the longest. We will store extra ones and give them to students when needed.
- ❖ 1 Small crayon or pencil box to hold pencils, crayons, etc,
- ❖ 1 Pair of scissors (Fiskars work best)
- ❖ 1 Pack of dry erase markers
- ❖ 1 One subject spiral notebook – wide ruled
- ❖ Erasers
- ❖ 3 Pocket folders (No large binders will be needed.)
